Appleinsider reported Feb 9, 2017: "Mac malware discovered in Microsoft Word document with autorunning macro", which was the second example of malware targeting macOS users this week.

Security researchers have detected the first in-the-wild instance of hackers are making use of malicious macros in Word documents to install malware on Mac computers an old Windows technique.
